

## **Gabriel Palmer (Ignace) Memorial Scholarship/Bursary Award 2018**

A scholarship/bursary has been established by the Ron Ignace Family in memory of their son Gabriel Palmer (Ignace).

The selection of the award recipient will be based on a combination of factors. Guidelines and criteria for receiving the Gabriel Palmer (Ignace) Scholarship/Bursary Award are as follows:

- Applicants must be of Aboriginal ancestry.
- Applicants must demonstrate an appreciation for Aboriginal culture and language; by showing that they regularly participate in Aboriginal events and celebrations **or** by writing a one page essay on “What role Aboriginal culture has played in my life”.
- Applicants must have a minimum Grade Point Average of 2.5.
- Applicants must demonstrate a financial need for the scholarship/bursary assistance.
- Applicants must demonstrate that they have been involved in school and/or community service by describing the types of activities that they have helped with or participated in.

**The amount of the award for 2018 is approx. \$500.** The award will be presented at School District 73 (Kamloops/Thompson) Aboriginal Graduation Ceremony.

NOTE: The funds in this award will be credited directly to your postsecondary institution, once you have been accepted into your Program and show proof of registration in your course.
